Trojan Triumph


Trojan Triumph is a grant-funded program for before/after school care. It is only available on the days your child attends school.

Students are provided a free snack and then partake in the day's activity. The academic material is inspired by the daily classroom activities.


This program is **free** for the students.



Clothing





- Play clothes
- Weather appropriate
- Easy for children to take on/off
- If your child is prone to accidents sending an extra pair of underwear and pants might be a good idea
- Please practice shoe tying, zipping, and buttoning with your child

Separation

- This may be your first time saying goodbye to your child.
 Rest assured, your child's teacher has been through this transition many times.
- It can be difficult, but please know, it will be okay.
- It is best that you say goodbye at the door.
- Remind your child that kindergarten is FUN!
